EVERYTHING YOU NEED TO KNOW

INFO E-LINE If you can't find what you're after here, there or anywhere, drop us an email: hello@intothewyldes.com (please be patient on the reply, we're a small but friendly crew!)

ADDRESS We're at: 'The Wyldes', Lower Exe Farm, Week St Mary, Nr Bude, Cornwall, EX22 6UX. Don't be too trusting of your sat-nav..Look for the The Wyldes signs instead! Type The Wyldes into Google Maps and you should find us. Although we have full traffic management in place it is still down Cornish lanes so please allow plenty of time to get here, even if you are local.

TIMES So long as you have a ticket, you can turn up at The Wyldes from 10:00 on the day of your show. We will be opening the main arena area from 11:00. From there it continues right up to 01:00 am. If you are camping with us just for one night, you are welcome to stay until 13:00 the following day, with you content and happy and ready to head back to real life, we'll gently coax you from The Wyldes by releasing a big, hairy, Cornish hillbilly.

ENTRY Do remember when you produce your e-ticket print out, you'll be given a wristband. For access to and from the show you will need to keep this wristband on. Once it's off, we're afraid we won't be able to let you back on site. Anyone seen without a wristband in the arena risks being politely escorted off site, so please do make sure your wristband is visible. Our entry gate is open until 21:00 in the evenings and then reopens at 10:00 the following morning. If you have a wristband, you can come and go as you please, but if you don't you'll have to wait until the entry gate is open at 10:00 to get one. We also reserve the right to turn anyone away from the event if we (or our very nice security personnel) deem it necessary.

ID/AGE VERIFICATION If you're over 18, we'll need you to bring some form of photo ID, so that you can be allocated an over-18 wristband. Please note that photocopies are not accepted! We need the real deal. This can be a passport, drivers licence, Prove It cards, Citizen cards or any other valid photo ID (please check first if necessary at hello@intothewyldes.com (Anyone under 18 must be accompanied by a ticket holding adult aged 25 or over.)

DOLLAR There are no cash machines on site so please keep that in mind. Bring the cash you need plus a little bit more just in case.

KIDDIES Children aged 5 or under are free of charge, but do need constant supervision by a ticket-holding adult. All persons under the age of 18 are expected to be under adult supervision by an adult of 25 or over.

PREPARE It's August Bank holiday! And anyway, it never rains in Cornwall. However, on the off chance that it does, make sure you come prepared. We recommend wet weather gear and wellies!

PUBLIC SHOWERS We have these too. Keep your bits fresh and happy.

RECYCLING We're aiming for ZERO LANDFILL again this year. However, it is highly expensive and we need your help. We'll be handing out rubbish bags to campers so you can keep your spots clean, and we've got lots of litter and bottle bins dotted all over the site, so please do use them. If you can take your rubbish home with you, we'll love you all the more for it. Thanks x

CAMPING You will need a separate camping ticket if you plan to stay over. If you wish to bring a motorhome you must have a camping ticket plus an additional campervan ticket for your vehicle. We have a general campsite, a van campsite and a family-friendly campsite. Campervans and caravans will be allowed into the van campsite only (no cars). Please note that the campervan area is just the other side of the car park, and each campervan will be allocated one additional tent space each. Anyone wishing to camp in these areas in tents does so at their own risk.

GO COMEDY GOLD CG tickets give access to the backstage bar area with a relaxed lounge bar and flushing toilets. If purchased with a camping ticket it gives access to a separate camping area with flushing toilets and showers.

PETS Awwww we love pets! Sadly though, we cannot allow our little sidekicks on to the site. Dogs, cats, once feral and now domesticated badgers with a beguiling underbite - sadly, it's a blanket ban for all of them.

BOOZE NO personal alcohol is allowed in the main arena throughout any event. We will be operating a strict LOOK 25 POLICY. Anyone who looks to be underage with what appears to be an alcoholic drink in their hand will be asked for ID, or risk having their drink confiscated. Anyone under 18 years old will automatically have their drink confiscated. If you're lucky enough to have an age-free face, bring your valid ID! (PLEASE NOTE: Glass and glass bottles are not allowed anywhere on site whatsoever.)

DRUGS We have a zero-tolerance policy towards drugs. If you are caught using, or are in possession of illegal drugs or legal highs including nitrous oxide (nos) along with associated items including but not limited to balloons, CO2 dispensers and whipped cream dispensers, our friendly but firm security team will immediately ask you to leave the site.

FOOD As well as our own café and grill there will be many other gourmet food stalls in attendance. So no need to eat before you come.

TRAVEL Our nearest town is Bude, in North Cornwall. If you're travelling by train, our nearest train stations are Bodmin and Exeter. From there, with a bit of forward planning, you can get a bus to (or close to) Bude. Go to www.travelinesw.com to check out bus times.

BUDE > THE WYLDES > BUDE SHUTTLE RUNS We've teamed up with our friend Stacey at Robs Travel, and him and his team will be providing shuttle runs to and from the site entrance. These will be running from the Strand Bus Shelter in Bude (opposite the Globe Hotel) to the shuttle stop at The Wyldes (and vice versa) during the following periods:

FRIDAY:	12:00 - 24:00
SATURDAY:	12:00 - 24:00
SUNDAY:	12:00 - 24:00

Shuttle runs will be £7.50 per person per trip (cash only - there are several cash machines close to the Strand Bus Shelter should you need them!). If you need to get in touch with Stacey to check on his arrival/departure times, call: 07771 824141.

FIRE & BBQS No fires on the campsite please. Instead, we'll provide a huge one in the arena for all of you. However, personal BBQ's and small camping stoves are permitted with the following conditions:

1. Disposable BBQs are really bad for the world. Keep this in mind!
2. NEVER put a small BBQ or stove in your tent or awning, even if it's been dampened down.
3. Keep your BBQ at a safe distance from other tents.
4. Act responsibly, take your rubbish home, and offer passers-by a sausage should you have any spare.

SOUND Rest assured, we've got enough music to keep you occupied here at The Wylde. So we don't allow any other sound systems on site. In-car stereos included.

FEEL SAFE We have 24-hour security on site. They're professional and friendly. Should you experience any problems or see anything suspicious, please speak to one of our security staff.
